



It is highly encouraging for staff and students of Govt. Degree College Dangiwacha, stepping into more upright and rewarding publication of Newsletter, 2023.




5th semester students won the competition by defeating 6th semester students. The programme was witnessed by all faculty members and students.

SYMPOSIUM ON THE THEME TRUTH AND NON-VIOLENCE


